Handling Instructions

Cream Pies: Chocolate Meringue Pie, Coconut Meringue Pie, Lemon Meringue Pie

- Cream Pies should be refrigerated. Freezing these pies can affect their appearance and make their crusts soft. They should last 4-5 days if refrigerated.
- Keep products away from direct sunlight

Fruit Pies: Apple Pie, Dutch Apple Pie, No Sugar Added Apple Pie, Blackberry Pie, Wild Blueberry Pie, Razzleberry Pie, Cherry Pie, Peach Pie, Raisin Pie

- Fruit Pies have a shelf life of 4-5 days without refrigeration. Refrigerating our fruit pies will make them last 2-3 more days. Fruit pies can be frozen. We recommend placing the pie in a freezer bag and putting it back in it's original box for best freezing results. Fruit pies may be frozen for approximately 1-2 months. Pies frozen longer than 2 months aren't harmful, they just aren't at their peak flavor and texture.
- To thaw a pie, immediately place it in a 350 degree oven for 25-30 minutes and then serve.
- Keep products away from direct sunlight

Pumpkin Pies

- Pumpkin pies should be refrigerated. Freezing these pieces can affect their appearance and make their crusts soft. They should last 4-5 days when refrigerated.
- Keep products away from direct sunlight

Pumpkin Rolls

- Our pumpkin rolls have a cream cheese filing and should be refrigerated. They should last 4-5 days.
- Our pumpkin rolls can be frozen. For best results, keep them in saran wrap and place them back in their original box. They may be frozen for approximately 1 to 2 months. Pumpkin rolls frozen longer than 2 months aren't harmful, they just aren't at their peak flavor and texture.

Nut Logs

- Nut logs may be frozen. Wrap them in saran wrap or in a large freezer bag. They may be frozen approximately 1-2 months. Nut logs frozen longer than 2 months aren't harmful, they just aren't at their peak flavor and texture.

Easter Breads

- Our Easter bread may also be frozen for up to 2 months. Wrap the loaf in a freezer bag for best results. Easter breads frozen longer than 2 months aren't harmful, they just aren't at their peak flavor and texture.
